

Everyone is asked to bring their own jug (and any extras you may have.) A limited supply of jugs will be available.

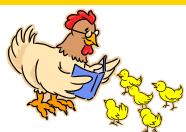

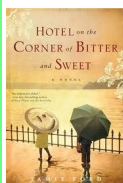
