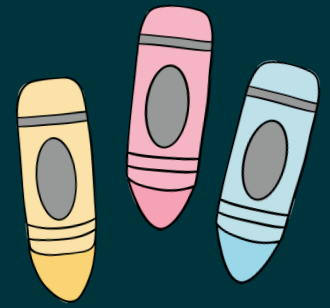

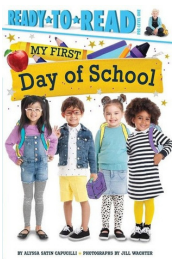


It's Your First Day of School, Busy Bus!

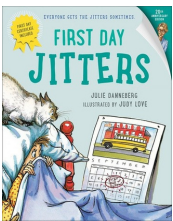


The Pigeon Has to Go to School!

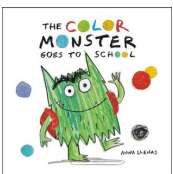

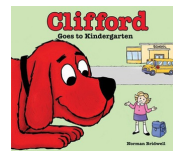


The Kissing Hand

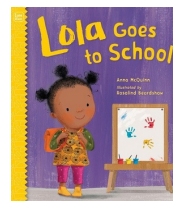


Clifford Goes to Kindergarten

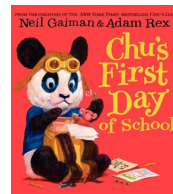


Lola Goes to School

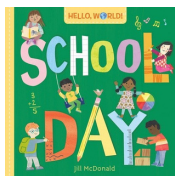
