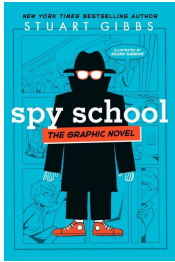

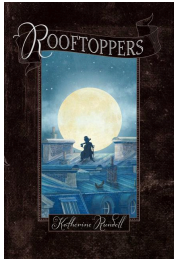


## Spy School : The Graphic Novel

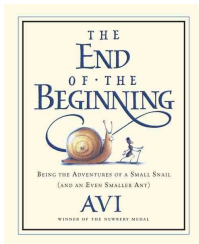


## Rooftoppers

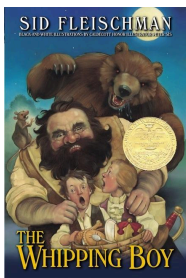

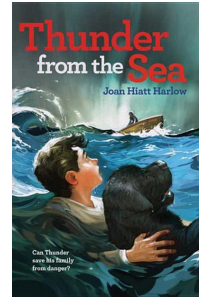


## Sheep

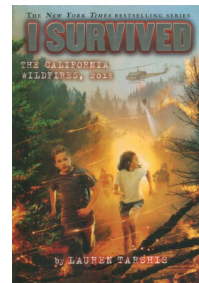

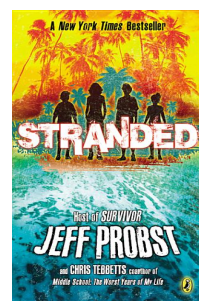


## I survived the California Wildfires, 2018

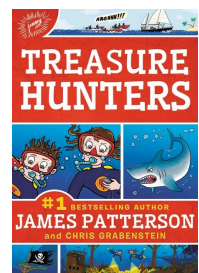


## Stranded

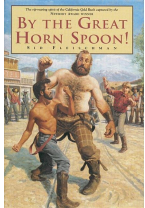

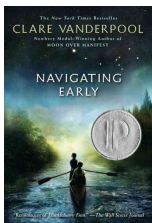

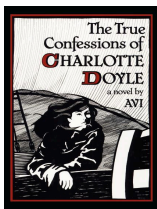


## Navigating Early

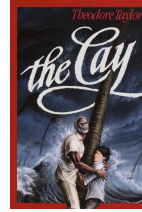

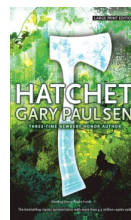

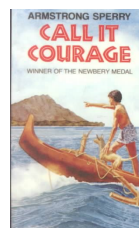
