Drop In Gaman Bird Craft May 18-23, All Day

Kids ages 3-12, drop in to make a clothespin bird craft inspired by gaman art, objects made by Japanese Americans imprisoned during World War II using whatever materials were available, such as fabric, shells, and paper. Wooden bird pins were a popular craft and expressions of beauty in the incarceration camps.

This program is offered to celebrate One Book, One Coast, a multi-state reading initiative. This year's selection is *They Called Us Enemy* by George Takei, a memoir recounting the author's experience of incarceration during World War II. Check out the book display near the service desk to learn more about the Japanese American incarceration experience and One Book, One Coast.
